SCHEDULE to OC 135 / 2026

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Gas Inspection (Adoption of Codes) Amendment Regulations, 2026*.

RRS c G-3.2 Reg 1 amended

2 *The Gas Inspection Regulations* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

Section 9 amended

3 Subsection 9(2) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(2) A temporary permit expires on the date that:

- (a) is specified on the temporary permit; and
- (b) must not be more than 200 days after the date of issue”.

Section 16 amended

4(1) Subsection 16(1) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(1) In this section:

- (a) ‘*Canadian Hydrogen Installation Code*’ means CAN/BNQ 1784-000/2022, as amended from time to time;
- (b) ‘*Code for digester gas, landfill gas, and biogas generation and utilization*’ means ANSI/CSA-B149.6-25, as amended from time to time;
- (c) ‘*Code for the field approval of fuel-burning appliances and equipment*’ means CSA-B149.3-25, as amended from time to time;
- (d) ‘*Compressed natural gas refuelling station installation code*’ means CSA B108.1-23, as amended from time to time;
- (e) ‘*Installation code for propane fuel systems and containers on motor vehicles*’ means CSA-B149.5-25, as amended from time to time;
- (f) ‘*Liquefied natural gas - production, storage, and handling code*’ means CSA-Z276-22, as amended from time to time;
- (g) ‘*Liquefied natural gas refuelling station installation code*’ means CSA B108.2-23, as amended from time to time;

(h) ‘*Natural gas and propane installation code*’ means CSA-B149.1-25, as amended from time to time;

(i) ‘*Propane storage and handling code*’ means CSA-B149.2-25, as amended from time to time”.

(2) Subsection 16(5) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(5) A person who installs a vehicle refuelling appliance that uses compressed natural gas shall install the appliance in accordance with the *Compressed natural gas refuelling station installation code*.

“(5.1) A person who installs a vehicle refuelling appliance that uses liquefied natural gas shall install the appliance in accordance with the *Liquefied natural gas refuelling station installation code*.

“(5.2) A person who installs an appliance that uses liquefied natural gas shall install the appliance in accordance with the *Liquefied natural gas - production, storage, and handling code*”.

Coming into force

5(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on April 1, 2026.

(2) If these regulations are filed with the Registrar of Regulations after April 1, 2026, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
